Online Safety for staff and governors

Simon Aston, the Online Safety Officer at Northamptonshire County Council, will guide you through an interactive session covering the most popular apps and websites used by young people in Northamptonshire, ways to keep young people safe online (especially when using social media), statutory responsibilities, online grooming, developing policies, broadening staff and governors' understanding of their role in supporting online safety in their schools, understanding our digital footprint and - most importantly - resources and initiatives to take back and implement in your settings.

These sessions will ensure that you understand many of the potential risks our pupils face when accessing the internet.
